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GIFT AID - Your Questions Answered

(Please ensure you fill in your post code and also notify us if you change your name or address.)

- **Am I eligible to sign up for Gift Aid?**

If you are a UK tax payer, yes. Even if you are not employed, you are still eligible if you are paying tax on any of the following: Personal pension, Occupational pension, stocks and shares, Bank and Building society savings accounts, rental income, overseas and UK investment dividends.

- **Does it matter how much or little I give?**

No. There is no upper or lower limit to Gift Aid. We can reclaim the tax on any amount. And remember, for every £1 you give, we can reclaim 25p from the taxman.

- **I've already completed a declaration for another charity. Do I need to complete another one for Crossroads Orkney?**

Yes. You have to complete a separate form for each charity you want to benefit from Gift Aid.

- **Will I have to fill in a Gift Aid Declaration each time I make a donation?**

No you won't. This single Gift Aid Declaration will cover any donation you have made in the last 4 years and all donations you make in the future.

- **Will I have to give you details of my tax office?**

No. The Inland Revenue does not need this. Once you have completed the declaration, there are no more forms to complete.

- **What if I stop paying tax?**

You can cancel this arrangement at any time you choose, simply by telling us that you wish to do so. Tel: 01856 87 0500

- **I pay tax at the higher rate. Does this make a difference to Gift Aid?**

The good news is that you can still sign up to Gift Aid, and you can also reclaim the difference between the higher and lower tax bands on your charitable donations in your Self Assessment Tax return.

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
